- Pay online with credit card or pay in the office with cash or cheque.
- Refunds for those who score 3 or higher will be processed in September. Those who pay with credit card will be refunded onto their credit card. Those who pay cash or cheque will have a cheque mailed to them.
- To be eligible for university credit, a student must take an Advanced Placement exam in the subject area of study. Advanced Placement exams are administered in May. Please see attached for specific dates. The fee for each exam is \$100. Each college and university sets its own policies regarding the granting of credit for advanced placement. Students must check directly with the institution.

✓ Several sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Electronic equipment (cell phone, tablet, computer, iPod, cameras, devices that can access the Internet, any other electronic communication devices)
✓ Pens with black or dark blue ink	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unapproved aids: Books, compasses, mechanical pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes or coloured pencils
✓ A watch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Watches that beep or have an alarm
✓ Up to two AP approved calculators with the necessary capabilities if you are taking AP Biology (see below), Calculus, Chemistry or Physics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Computers or calculators (except those that are approved)
✓ A ruler or straightedge (<i>Physics exam only</i>) ✓ Protractors are not allowed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rulers, straightedges and protractors (except as noted)
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets)
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reference guides, keyboard maps or other typing instructions
